THE COURT:

IT IS ORDERED that respondent superior court show cause before this court when the matter is ordered on calendar why the relief requested in the petition for writ of mandate, prohibition, or other appropriate relief should not be granted.

Real parties in interest shall serve and file a return to the petition within thirty (30) days of the issuance of this order to show cause. The return shall identify the specific theory or theories of negligence that real parties in interest intend to pursue at trial, along with any legal authority that supports the theory or theories. Petitioner shall serve and file a return to the petition within twenty (20) days after the filing of the return.

The justices will be familiar with the facts and issues, will have conferred among themselves on the case, and will not require oral argument. If oral argument is requested, the request must be served and filed within seven (7) days after the deadline for petitioner to file a reply brief. If no

request for oral argument is filed on or before this date, the matter will be submitted at such time as the court approves the waiver and the time for filing all briefs and papers has expired. (California Rules of Court, rule 8.256(d)(1).) If oral argument is requested, the court will notify the parties of the exact date and time set for oral argument, which will occur before Division Four of this court at the courtroom located at 350 McAllister Street, San Francisco, California, or by videoconference.

The clerk of this court shall serve and file this order to show cause on petitioner on or before August 19, 2022. Counsel for petitioner is instructed to immediately serve all necessary parties in this litigation with a copy of this order. A proof of service reflecting such service shall be filed with this court no later than 5:00 p.m. on August 24, 2022.
