ORDER

Before: LUCERO,* W. FLETCHER, and IKUTA, Circuit Judges.

On December 15, 2021, the Supreme Court granted the petition for a writ of certiorari in *Viking River Cruises, Inc. v. Moriana*, 142 S. Ct. 734 (2021) (mem.).

A majority of the panel agrees that consideration of appellees' petition for rehearing en banc shall be deferred until *Viking River Cruises, Inc. v. Moriana* is decided. Judge Ikuta votes against deferring consideration of the petition for rehearing en banc until the Supreme Court resolves *Viking River Cruises, Inc. v. Moriana* because that case does not raise issues relevant to this appeal.
